### Vocation Corner Fifth Sunday of Lent – B

**A Vocation View:** Unless a seed first dries out and dies, it cannot be planted in the earth to grow. Unless we first dry out and die to our selfish ways, we can never expect to be people who will 'lay down their lives for their friends.'

**Prayer:** That God's name will be glorified, by the faithful love of those men and women being called by Christ to serve and follow Him as priests, deacons and in the consecrated life, we pray to the Lord.

**Action:** The consecrated life inspires and accompanies the spread of evangelization in the different parts of the world, where Institutes from abroad are gratefully welcomed and new ones are being founded, in a great variety of forms and expressions. Consequently, although in some parts of the world Institutes of Consecrated Life seem to be experiencing a period of difficulty, in other places they are prospering with remarkable vitality. ## Voir Jésus

Deux visiteurs grecs viennent à Jérusalem pour la Pâque. Il y a sans doute des rumeurs sur Jésus et les visiteurs veulent en savoir plus. Mais Jésus ne parle probablement pas le grec. Ils passent donc par Philippe (un nom à consonance grecque) et formulent leur demande : nous voulons voir Jésus.

Il n'y a aucun échange entre Jésus et ses interlocuteurs, ni question, ni réponse. Jésus semble perdu dans ses pensées et leur tient un discours déroutant sur son heure qui arrive, sur le renoncement, la mort, la peur, la gloire que le Père manifesterà. C'est l'heure du jugement. Quand il sera élevé de terre (à la fois crucifié et ressuscité), Jésus attirera à lui tous les hommes.

À première vue, le récit semble donc délirant. Deux hommes veulent voir Jésus et Jésus semble leur servir un discours complètement éclaté. Mais si on déplace un peu le récit, on voit vite autre chose. Chez saint Jean, *voir* signifie aussi *croire*. Voir Jésus c'est bien autre chose que serrer la main d'une vedette. C'est croire en lui. Mais qui donc est Jésus et quel est le chemin qui mène vers lui? À quoi faut-il croire pour vraiment voir Jésus? Quel est le secret de cet homme?

Voir Jésus, c'est, comme le grain de blé, s'enfouir dans la terre.

Voir Jésus, c'est accepter de perdre sa vie.

Voir Jésus, c'est ne pas reculer, ne pas céder à la peur

mais dire : *Père, glorifie ton nom...*

Voir Jésus, c'est affronter la croix et être élevé de terre.

Voir Jésus, c'est ressusciter avec le Seigneur.

Voir Jésus, c'est entrer dans le salut, un salut destiné à tous les hommes.
