Sunday May 27, 2018 Trinity Sunday

Since Pentecost, Christ's gift of the Holy Spirit changed our concept of God, the Church, and of ourselves.

The relationship of God the Father and Christ, his Son, is reflected in *Another* with whom they are united. With the Holy Spirit, this relationship among the three Persons reflects their magnificence and complexity. They are three: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. The essence of the Trinity is the open and loving relationship between three divine persons. We know this because love makes human relations alive and fruitful.

There is a beautiful expression from theologian Walter Kaspers, [President Emeritus, Pontifical Council of Promoting Christian Unity], "*in the Holy Spirit, who is God in us, we may know God above us, the Father, as the Son who is God among us*". (free translation)

The Church, without the Holy Spirit, would be inert, motionless or adrift. The Holy Spirit "*rejuvenates and renews it unceasingly*" as Vatican Council II reminds us.
