Vocation Corner Twenty - first Sunday of the Year - B

A Vocation View: Jesus teaches us about life everlasting. "Your words Lord are spirit and life ..." It is this that gives us hope when we despair, a way of living when we stray from God's way. "The words I have spoken are spirit and they are life." It is God's words that we need to hear to lift our spirit and give life. Pray for vocations.

Prayer: That trusting Christ, the Word of eternal life, all men and women called to follow the Lord as priests, deacons, sisters and brothers will be faithful to His invitation, we pray to the Lord.

Action: How far are you willing to go in your own life in to bring Good News to others? Consider the example of Saint Rose Philippine Duchesne (1769-1852), born in France, travelled all the way to St. Charles, Missouri to bring the Society of the Sacred Heart religious congregation to the U.S. Today the Society has 21 schools in the U.S. and is found in 44 countries around the world. Sacred Heart sisters focus on educating young women and emphasize in their curriculum the need for global awareness and building a more just world. You can carry on these efforts in your own neighborhood, parish, office, home, and see how far the Spirit moves you.

Choices and Good Decisions



After the multiplication of the loaves and a lively discussion with the disciples, a good number of them left Jesus. It was a pivotal moment. Jesus said to the twelve: *Do you want to leave too?* Peter took the lead and confirmed his faith in Christ: *You have the words of eternal life.*

I find this passage relevant. Many of us, myself included, lived in an era where the Christian tradition and faith were part of the predominant culture, even the air we breathed. No matter the question, Jesus was the answer.

Since those days, our culture has changed, along with our values and social order. Today we live in a pluralistic and highly secularized society that is often hostile to religion. There are also the influences of other religions, sects, and mystical currents of all kinds. It is not uncommon, then, that Christ's words may appear to be shocking, discouraging, and perhaps even obscure.

I hear Jesus ask us: *Do you want to leave, too?* Each one of us has to make that decision.

We reflect and exercise our free will. The choice is always ours. Remember that spirituality is a dimension that will enrich our lives. Like Peter, we must take the lead and live with our decision.

We have been touched and shocked upon hearing the news regarding the sexual abuse reports coming from Pennsylvania. It is a sad moment for the Church that brings us to our knees asking for God's mercy.

In response and in solidarity, I would invite everyone on **Tuesday, August 28, the Feast of St. Augustine, to celebrate the Eucharist and to do an hour of adoration for the victims of abuse and for the entire sexual abuse situation.**

Child abuse has been present in our world for many, many generations. Abuse is the umbrella under which we find harassment, bullying, child pornography, and sexual transgressions, taking away from our children their childhood and their innocence. The abuses which have happened by members of the clergy in our Church is totally and unequivocally unacceptable. Zero tolerance is our goal!

As Pope Francis reminds us, "Even though it can be said that most of these cases belong to the past, nonetheless as time goes on we have come to know the pain of many of the victims." It is this pain that people will carry their entire lifetime afflicting their physical, psychological, and spiritual growth. Let us be present to them.

May we carry all those affected in our thoughts and prayers.
