## **Une remise à neuf**

Jésus passe la plupart de son temps à parcourir les routes de Galilée. Il est comme un semeur sorti pour jeter généreusement la Parole du Royaume dans le cœur des hommes et des femmes de bonne volonté. De village en village, Jésus écoute la supplication des gens simples, guérit les malades, reconforte les pécheurs et pardonne les fautes; il discute aussi avec les experts religieux, scribes et pharisiens. Mais voici qu'aujourd'hui notre passage d'évangile raconte la deuxième portion d'une incursion en territoire étranger et païen. De retour de Tyr et de Sidon (sur le littoral de la Méditerranée), Jésus poursuit sa route vers la Décapole, un regroupement de dix villages d'origine grecque, situés en Transjordanie, au sud-est du lac de Galilée.

Des gens amènent à Jésus un sourd *qui avait aussi de la difficulté à parler et le supplie de poser la main sur lui* (Mc 7,32). Même écoute, même accueil à l'égard de ce païen que pour un juif. Jésus fera toutefois plus que ce que les gens demandent. Les gestes se succèdent les uns après les autres : *il lui mit les doigts dans les oreilles, et, avec sa salive, lui toucha la langue* (v. 33). À ces gestes curatifs, Jésus joint la prière en levant les yeux au ciel ; c'est Dieu qui réalisera la guérison de cet homme, comme si sa création n'était pas encore achevée. Jésus soupire et ordonne aux oreilles et à la langue : *Ouvre-toi*.

On assiste symboliquement à l'achèvement de la création chez ce païen, à tout le moins une remise à neuf. Les gestes de Jésus évoquent la manière divine de créer et de faire l'être humain, comme on le voit dans les deux récits de la Genèse (chapitres 1 et 2). Le toucher des oreilles et de la langue, la référence à Dieu par la prière, la parole créatrice se conjuguent ici pour montrer qu'il manquait à ce païen des oreilles pour entendre la Parole de Dieu et une bouche pour proclamer les louanges du Seigneur.

*Ouvre-toi !* Cet ordre de Jésus peut s'adresser à toute personne qui a besoin de guérison dans sa vie, qui aspire à la réconciliation, qui cherche de l'espoir, qui n'ose pas le pardon. Cet ordre *Ouvre-toi !* s'adresse aussi à tous les baptisés devenus timides, qui n'osent plus afficher leur foi ou leur identité chrétienne et catholique dans une société sécularisée. Le même ordre s'adresse aussi à l'Église qui peine à trouver des chemins de dialogue avec la culture moderne. « Ouvre-toi ! » est une injonction pressante à sortir de nos enfermements.
