### *Vocation Corner* – 28<sup>th</sup> Sunday of the Year – B

**A Vocation View:** If we really believe in something, it does not seem to be a sacrifice to give up everything else to pursue that one dream. Jesus asks for total dedication, promising in return rewards that no one else can promise: "Go and sell everything you own ... then come; follow me."

**Prayer:** That those chosen to leave all and follow Jesus more closely in the priesthood or consecrated life will respond with the wisdom and understanding given by the Holy Spirit, we pray to the Lord.

**Action:** Invited to leave everything to follow Christ, you, consecrated men and women, no longer define your life by family, by profession, or by earthly interests, and you choose the Lord as your only identifying mark. ### **Suivre la Parole**

Le passage de l'évangile de Marc que nous propose la liturgie d'aujourd'hui est l'un des plus intrigants qui soit. Un homme demande à Jésus quoi faire pour avoir part à la vie éternelle. Jésus lui rappelle ce que nous appelons les dix commandements, le *décalogue*, ce qui signifie les dix paroles. Cela je le fais, répond le jeune homme. Et le récit de Marc dit ceci : *Jésus posa son regard sur lui et il l'aima*. Le jeune homme n'a pas le courage de suivre Jésus *car il avait de grands biens*.

L'interprétation morale que l'on fait de ce texte est bien connue. Elle porte sur l'attachement aux richesses qui nous entrave le cœur et nous empêche de faire des choix audacieux. Nul d'entre nous n'est vraiment ni totalement libre face à l'argent car cela détermine souvent nos chances de survie dans une société basée sur l'argent.

Mais l'attitude de Jésus va beaucoup plus loin que la question de l'argent. Le texte dit que Jésus le regarda et l'aima. Il se met à l'aimer. On ne sait pas trop ce que cela veut dire, mais il y a ici une intensité de relation personnelle inédite. L'homme en question respecte bien les dix Paroles (décalogue ou dix commandements). Voici que Jésus, la Parole par excellence, le regarde, l'aima et l'invite à aller plus loin. L'homme n'est pas capable de faire ce choix.

Combien de gens en restent aux *commandements* et n'osent pas la foi?
