Ombre et lumière

La liturgie du Carême varie d'une année à l'autre mais pour les deux premiers dimanches l'ordre des récits est le même : la tentation au premier dimanche et la transfiguration au deuxième.

La tentation nous dévoile le côté sombre de la vie, son aspect conflictuel et difficile. La vie est un combat, nous ne le savons que trop, un combat toujours recommencé qui réclame de notre part une vigilance constante.

Dans cette lutte, nous ne sommes jamais seuls. Quelqu'un nous accompagne, nous soutient et se révèle toujours un guide sûr. Quand le bateau est secoué par la tempête et risque de perdre sa route, il est salutaire de voir au loin un phare qui donne un repère. Quand la peur et l'angoisse nous assaillent, comme il fait bon d'avoir un ami ou un guide pour nous prendre la main et nous redonner confiance. Quand Jésus fait route avec les siens et que les difficultés se profilent et que le danger devient imminent, il se dévoile à eux dans le mystère de son être divin. Son visage devient lumière et redonne force à leur conviction.

La transfiguration n'est pas simplement l'expérience de Pierre, Jacques et Jean à un seul instant de leur vie. Elle est aussi notre propre expérience quand, au bord du doute et de la détresse, nous savons fermer les yeux et laisser le maître intérieur se dévoiler à nous. Heureux ceux et celles qui acceptent d'aller sur la montagne à la rencontre du Seigneur : la lumière est au rendez-vous.
